Certified Professional in Erosion and Sediment Control Certification Program (CPESC)

This Certification provides professional credentials to individuals working on construction site erosion and sedimentation control issues. Registrants must understand minimum requirements of the USEPA NPDES Program as it relates to construction site erosion and sedimentation control. Registrants must also demonstrate proficiencies in site planning and management, erosion prediction, runoff management, soil stabilization, erosion control and sediment control. Registrants must meet candidate qualifications and complete an application to EnviroCert, International, Inc.

Certified Erosion Sediment and Storm Water Inspector Certification Program (CESSWI)

This Certification provides professional credentials to individuals working on construction sites performing for erosion, sedimentation and storm water inspections. Registrants must understand the minimum requirements of USEPA NPDES Program and demonstrate proficiencies in site safety, communication, documentation, inspector duties and plan management. Additionally, registrants must possess a full understanding of the following aspects of Best Management Practices (BMP): purpose, objective, targeted pollutants, applications, limitations, implementation considerations, inspection criteria and maintenance. Registrants must meet candidate qualifications and complete an application to EnviroCert, International, Inc.

Certified Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Specialist Certification Program (CMS4S)

This Certification provides professional credentials to individuals working in qualified MS4 Program management. Registrants must understand the minimum requirements for the USEPA NPDES Program Permit requirements and must document proficiencies in each of the NPDES Minimum Control Measures (MCM's) as well as overall program management and documentation, program funding and program audits and evaluations. Registrants must meet candidate qualification and complete an application to EnviroCert, International, Inc.
